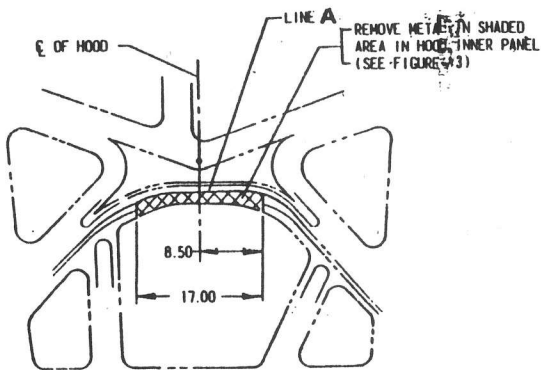

FIGURE #1 PROCEDURE FOR INSTALLING PACKAGE

- STEP #1 REMOVE EXISTING UNDERHOOD PAD (IF SO EQUIPPED), HOOD ORNAMENT, AIR CLEANER AND AIR CLEANER STUD. RETAIN HOOD ORNAMENT NUTS AND AIR CLEANER NUT. SEE FIGURES #2 & #6 AND SEE CAUTION NOTE BELOW.
- STEP #2 MODIFY HOOD ORNAMENT BY REMOVING METAL AND RIBS AS SHOWN (SHADED AREA) IN FIGURES #3 & #4.
- STEP #3 CUT HOOD INNER PANEL ALONG LINE "A" (17 INCHES WIDE) AND REMOVE METAL (SHADED AREA) AS SHOWN IN FIGURES #1 & #3.
- STEP #4 CUT HOOD OPENING REINFORCEMENT ALONG LINES B AND C. SEE FIGURES #2 & #4 FOR AREA TO BE CUT (SHADED AREA).
- STEP #5 AFTER MODIFYING HOOD INNER PANEL, HOOD OPENING REINFORCEMENT AND ORNAMENT INSTALL MODIFIED HOOD ORNAMENT USING EXISTING NUTS AS SHOWN IN FIGURE #2.
- STEP #6 INSTALL SHROUD & SEAL ASS'Y, STUD, AIR CLEANER ELEMENT AND COVER AND L EXISTING NUT AS SHOWN IN FIGURE #6.

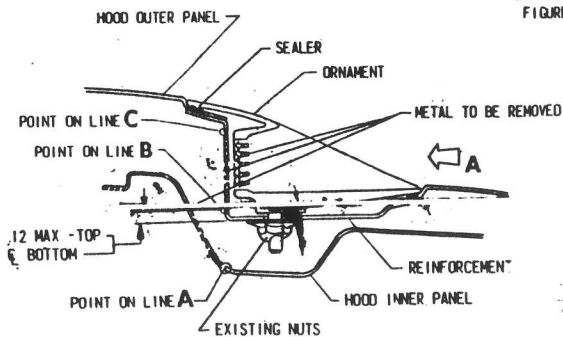
