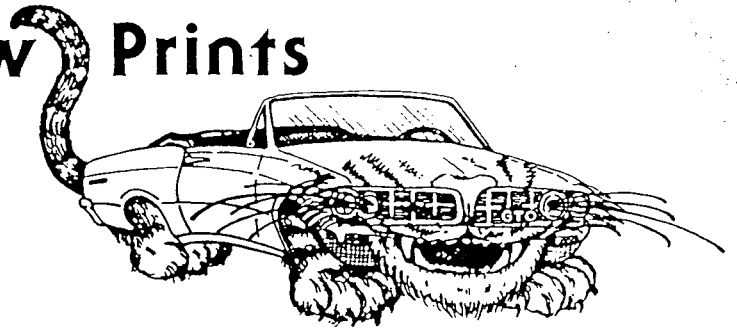

Having tech sessions, concourse show, drag race, road rally. It was also brought up about having a participant vote instead of the judging. The biggest concern on a two day show was that it would take a lot of work almost comparable to the national meet. Getting the help, finding a place to hold it. Doug Smith, Lynn Inskeep and Nancy Whaley felt it should still be a spring show as everyone wants to get their cars out. Lynn Inskeep brought up having a cruise night with a DJ and food because we possibly cannot afford the drag strip. Richard is to find out if we can even get the drag strip in May. Mark Baker asked about renting the fairgrounds. Doug Smith stated it might cost around \$200 to rent. He also stated that the Etna Lions Club rents their building and grounds for \$125 a day. Another concern is that if we don't hold the show at a hotel it needs to be in an aread that has hotels, paved area, food and easy to get to. Lynn and Neal stated it would be hard to get a special rate at hotel unless we could promise a number of people, and that hotels are already booking for next year. Neal felt the Marriott would gladly take us back even though it was on a smaller scale than the nationals. Neal suggested calling other chapters and seeing if they would be interested in attending or helping. We would need something to draw people to our show for two days. Kurt Pearce suggested sending letters out on a two day show at least two states away to see if they would be interested in attending before we make that decision. Richard stated if we do a two day show we will be stuck with all judging, and a lot of trophies. Where we get a lot of help from other chapters on the nationls, we might not get any help on our two day show. Neal Blankenship stated his feelings were to do a one day show with a cruise at a local hotel because of the parking spaces, have the swap meet and concourse show. There will be more discussion on this matter later but we need to start moving on this immediately. If you have any suggestions or concerns please call one of the officers.

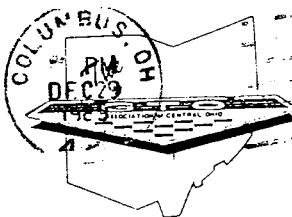
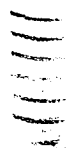

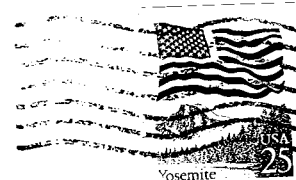
