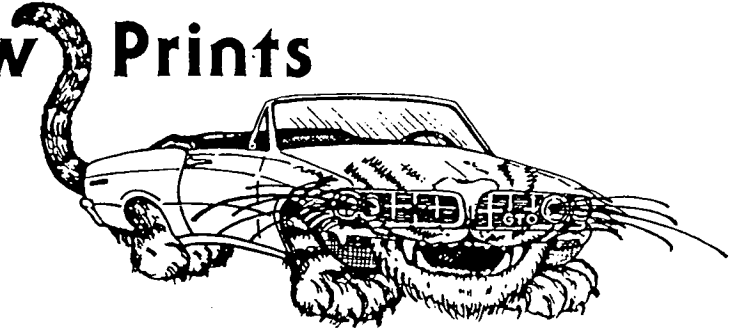

SUBJECT: Quarterly Update

We again have a number of items to inform you about. Plans are progressing well for the Nationals and we are looking forward to seeing all of you there.

1. We will again have a Chapter meeting at the Nats, and it is scheduled for Saturday afternoon. We would again like to limit it to one or two reps per Chapter.

2. We would like to advise you of the loss of a Chapter. The Classic GTO Assoc. of Denver has chosen to not have any of its officer team be GTOAA members, therefore, they no longer meet our one and only requirement for affiliation. Please drop them from your rosters.
3. We also have a number of other Chapters who have at least one member of their officer team who is not a GTOAA member. We have offered the officer \$15.00 renewal rate to make it as easy as possible, we do not like to have to act like the Police by checking up on you. We hope that every Chapter can be responsible and check their own officers. We will be glad to verify membership status of your own Chapter officers, if you will contact us. We would like to have you fill out and return to us the enclosed form.
4. We also have some other important information to share with you that we would like your response and reaction to. These can be topics for discussion at the Chapter meeting as well. In December in a phone conversation with Lars, he asked if we would be interested in one of us being on the Board of Directors. We said yes, in that we feel we could much better represent the interests of the Chapters as a Board Member. However, as of this date nothing has yet come through from Lars confirming this Board position. We also put together a list of suggestions for changes and/or improvements to the GTOAA that we submitted to Lars and Bob. These were sent 3/3/90 and we have also had no response to these ideas. We continue to remain committed to the success and growth of the GTOAA, but we do feel that some sort of communication must occur.
5. We also need to remind you that the insurance policy that the GTOAA has is a liability policy for protection of officers of the GTOAA and Chapter sponsors of events. It does not cover peoples cars or any other property, and we cannot write a rider on it to protect a mall, etc. It is to protect us as officers and event sponsors from being sued. To request event coverage please send us the form. DO NOT contact the insurance company directly, they cannot help you, as all requests must come through us. We will send you the updated policy coverage page, when we get same from Lars.

We would also like to congratulate the Chapters on the excellent newsletters that we are getting from you. We have some really excellent Chapter organizations out there, and we are proud to say that you are GTOAA Affiliated Chapters.

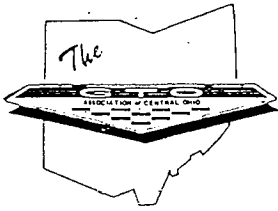
