WELCOME

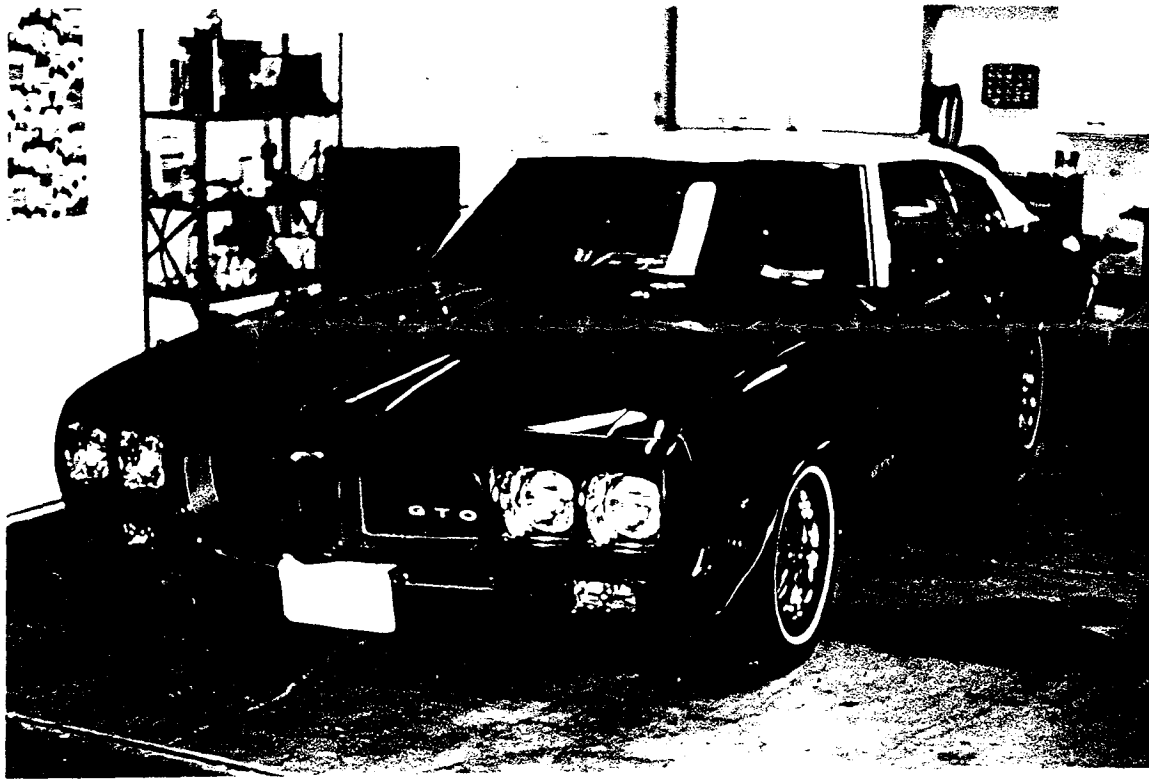
New member Bill Hartley wrote a short story about his 1965 Charcoal Blue GTO.
