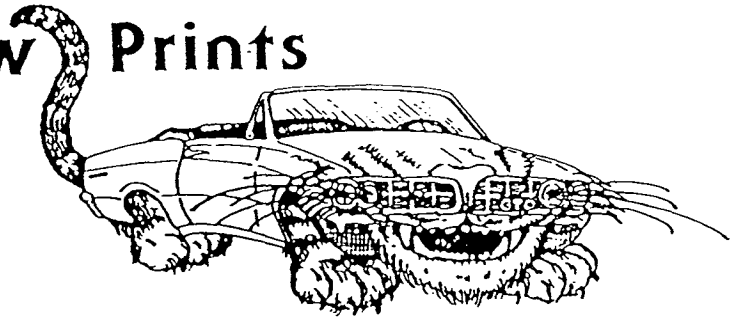

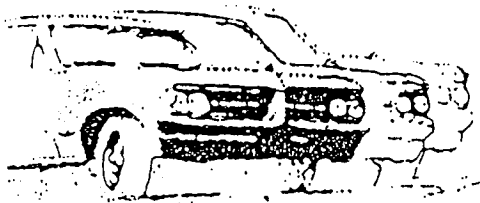

- ° The vendor turnout was to buildings capacity
 - * due to spacing, seven vendors had to be turned down
- ° The customer turnout this year was a decrease from previous years
 - * The Springfield Swap Meet was the same day, plus inclement weather
- ° Minimal comments from vendors regarding placement or "favoritism"
 - * placement was on a first come, first serve-type basis with available space placement (which was noted on flyer)
- ° The Banner indicating a second building needs to be more permanently attached for better visibility
 - * will be anchored better and earlier next year

All in all, the Swap Meet was a financially successful club event. KEVIN JOHNSTON was commended for his fine efforts and a THANKS to ALL members who helped that day.

NANCY WHALEY (and the BENSON's if needed) will purchase the door prizes for the Spring Show.


