

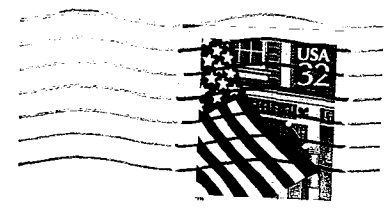

GTOAA Nationals: Dan Gregory reported that you should get your reservations in early. Also, do not call the 1-800 number but call the main hotel for your reservations.

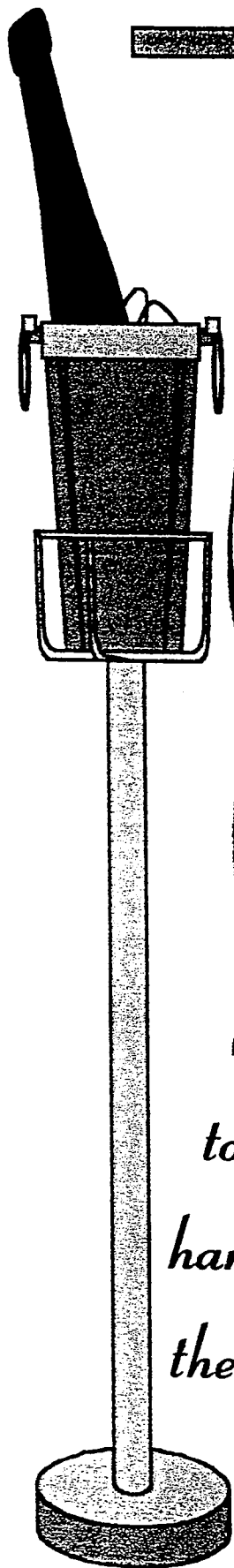

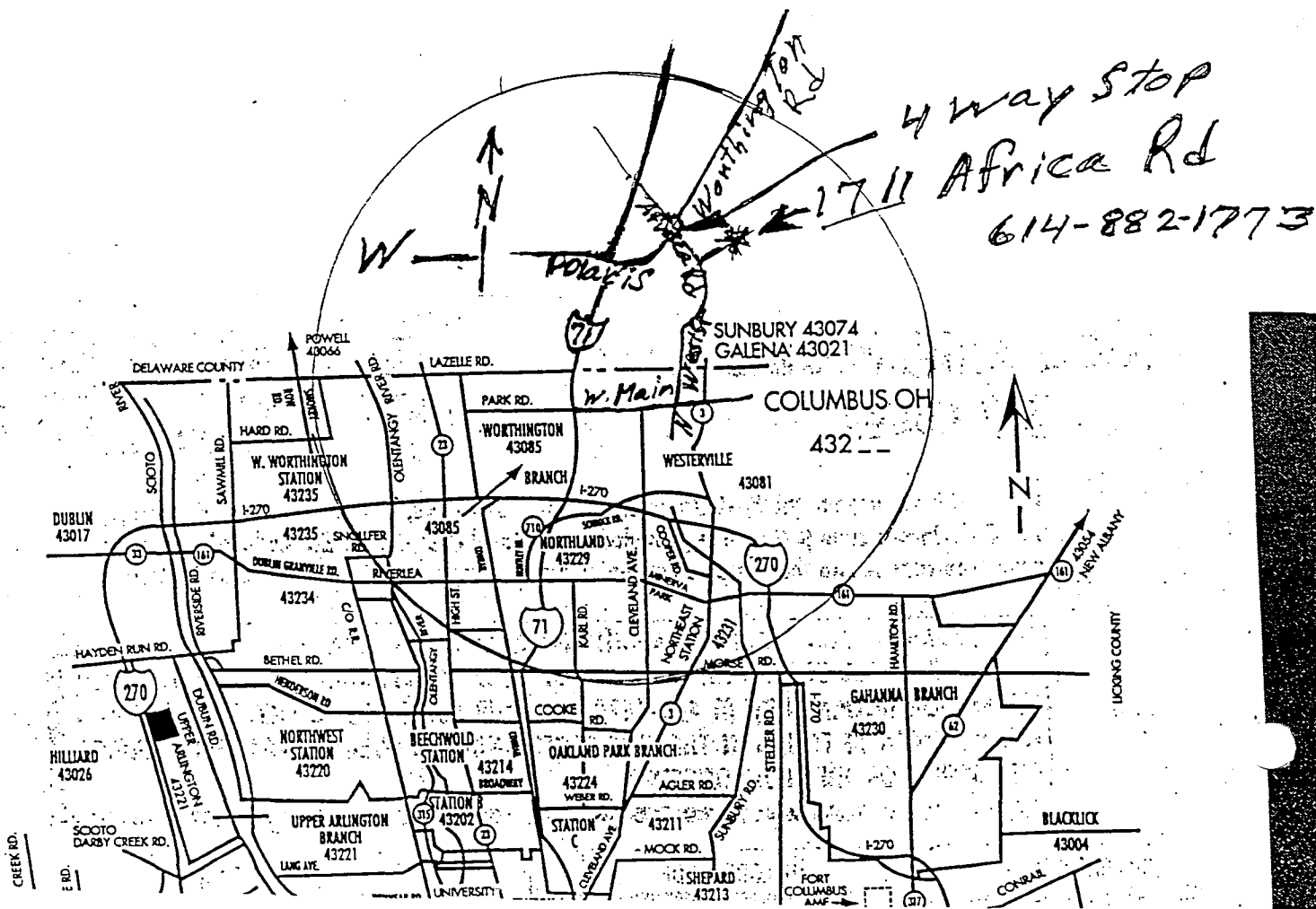
Polaris Exit Turn East
