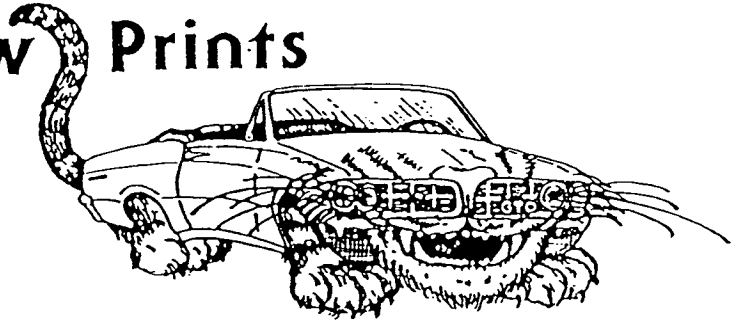

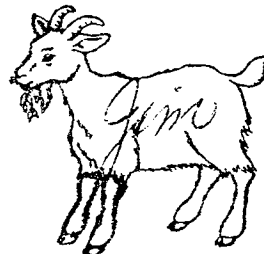
TO ALL MY GTO FRIENDS:

Maintenance

On Your Daily Drivers

Proper car care and preventive maintenance can make any modern car last 150,000 to 200,000 miles. Remember that the full service station is almost a thing of the past. When you fill up with gas be sure to check your oil at least every other time. Oil is the life blood of your engine. Most cars are driven locally with average trips of under 4 miles or under 10 miles in winter conditions when outside temperatures are below freezing. Under these conditions the following service plan works:

Every 3 to 4 months or 3,000 - 4,000 miles:
Oil change, oil filter and lube. Then have the service person check:

- engine coolant level
- windshield washer fluid
- brake fluid
- tire pressure
- power steering fluid
- battery level
- automatic transmission fluid
- differential lubricant level (R.W.D.)
- hoses and belts - replace belts if cracked, frayed or worn
- boots on front wheel drive axles. Replace worn boots at once. It's much cheaper than purchasing replacement axles.

Every 12 months or 12,000 to 15,000 miles:
Have the tires rotated. Front wheel drive cars are hard on front tires and rear wheel drives are hard on the rear tires.

Also check the air pressure in the spare tire.

Every 24 months or 24,000 to 30,000 miles:
Replace the air filter and P.C.V. if required. New spark plugs. Check timing. Check coolant and freeze protection. If dirty or rusty, drain, flush and refill with new coolant. Replace the fuel filter.

Every 50,000 miles or 4 years:

- Change the automatic transmission fluid and filter.
- Have the wheels pulled and check and replace brake pads and lining as necessary.
- Pack front wheel bearings on rear wheel drive cars.
- Some 4 cylinder F.W.D. cars with overhead cams require timing belt replacement. Read your owner's manual.
- Replace the battery before it lets you down.

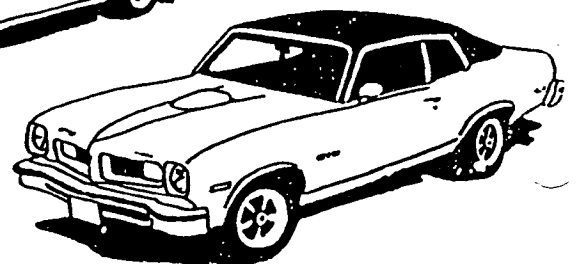
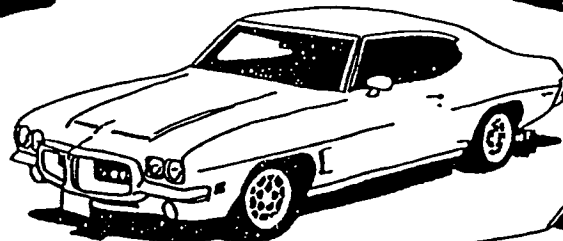
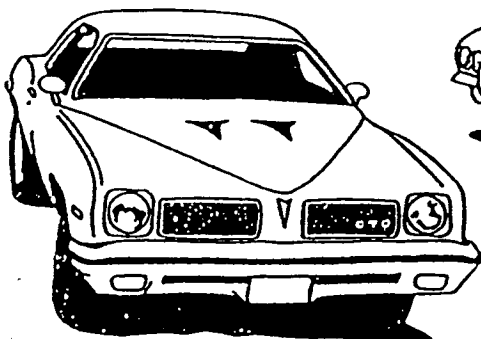
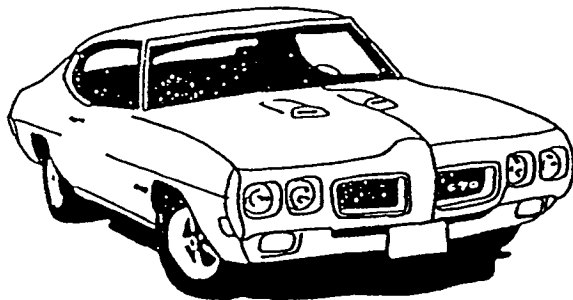
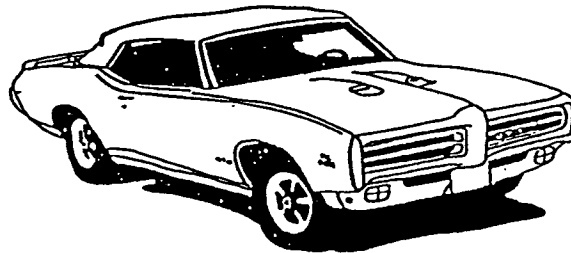
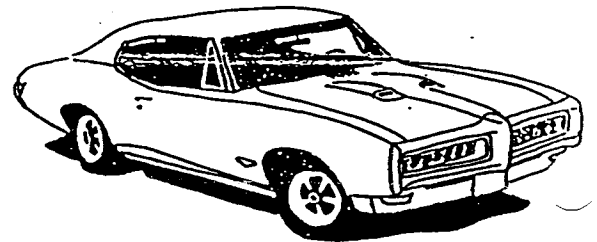
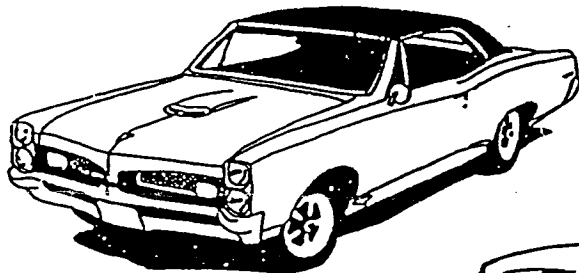
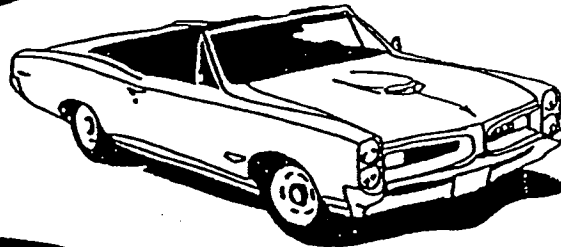
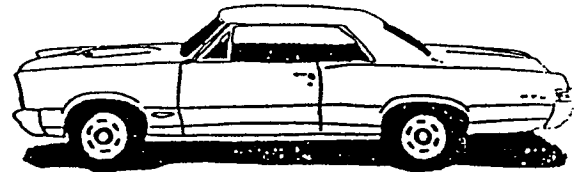
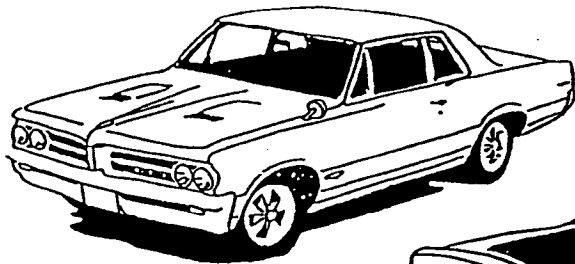
Every 75,000 miles:

- Replace the distributor cap and plug wires. (Some new cars don't have distributors.)
- Check shocks and struts.

If you are not into having a new car every 2 or 3 years, preventive maintenance works. Investment advisors say that the most sensible way to own a car is to pay it off quickly and then drive it for 10 years! (It's also a good idea to purchase a car that is about 12 - 18 months old. Someone purchasing a new car takes about a 10 - 15 percent equity hit just driving off the lot. Let someone else take the hit and pay the dealer prep and other miscellaneous charges. ED)

SUBJECT: 1965 PONTIAC AND TEMPEST ENGINE OIL CAPACITY

There has been some confusion regarding the engine oil capacity of the 1965 Pontiac and Tempest engines.

The oil capacity for all V-8 engines, Pontiac and Tempest, is 5 qts. without a filter change and 6 qts. with a filter change. The Tempest 6-cylinder engine has an oil capacity of 4 qts. without a filter change and 5 qts. with a filter change.

	Filter Change	
	Without	With
Pontiac & Tempest All 8-Cyl.	5 qts.	6 qts.
Tempest 6 Cyl.	4 qts.	5 qts.

When checking engine oil level, the readings on the dip stick may fluctuate depending upon the engine oil temperature and drain-back period.

With a cool engine, the oil has had a chance to drain down into the pan resulting in a proper dip stick reading; in some cases, slightly above the full mark.

SUBJECT: GTO AND 2+2 DECOR STRIPE INSTALLATION

1. Wipe area to be striped with a wax removing solvent and a clean cloth.

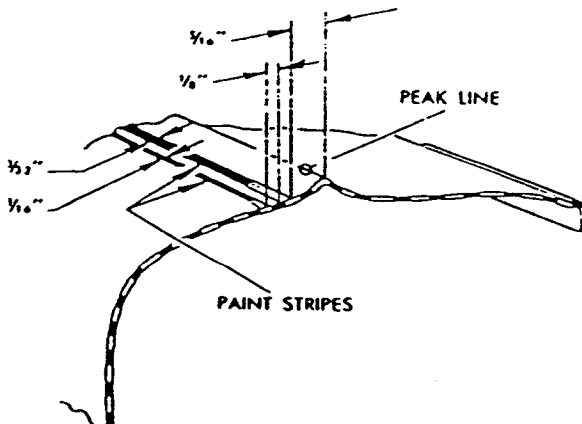
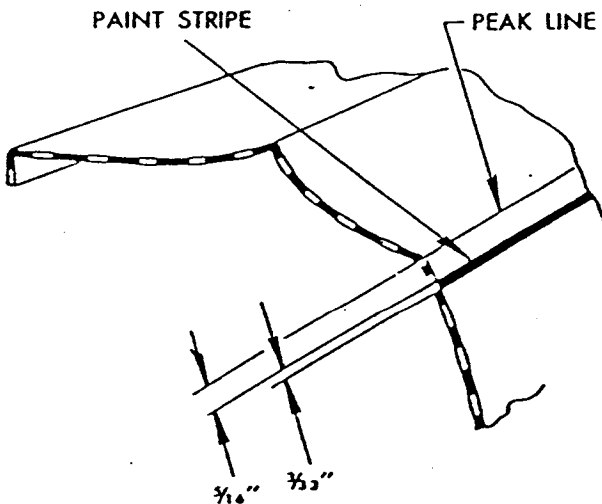
A. Spacing of tape on the panels should be as follows:

GTO Models -- Top of stripe should be $5/16"$ below the accent line on the upper edge of the panel. The top of the tape will follow approximately $1/8"$ below this accent line (Fig. II).

2+2 Models -- The top of the upper paint stripe should be $5/16"$ below the accent line on the upper edge of the panel. The top of the tape will follow this line. The second stripe will be spaced $1/8"$ below the top stripe (Fig. III).

- B. On severe corners, such as are encountered at the rear quarter panel extension, it will facilitate installation of the tape if the required length is cut, separated and applied as individual strips in the proper sequence.

- C. Sight down the length of the panel and check for accuracy of tape line.

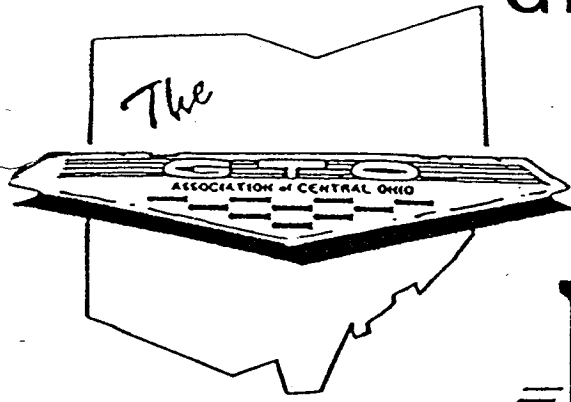
