

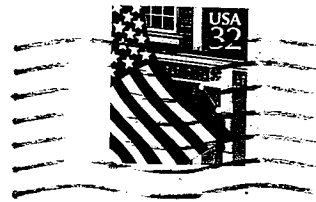

To all my GTO friends,

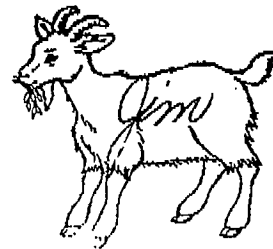
