A great time was had by everyone!

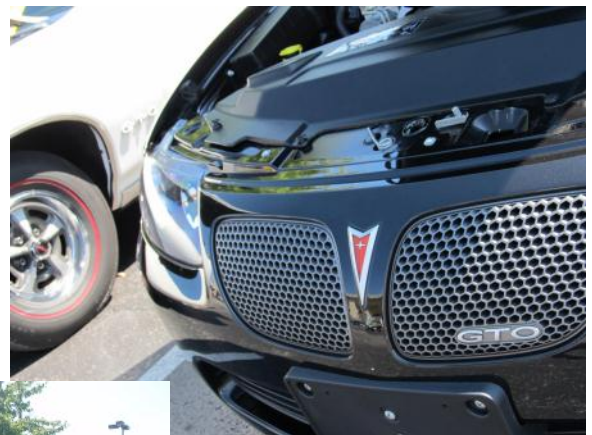


# Rods and Bods

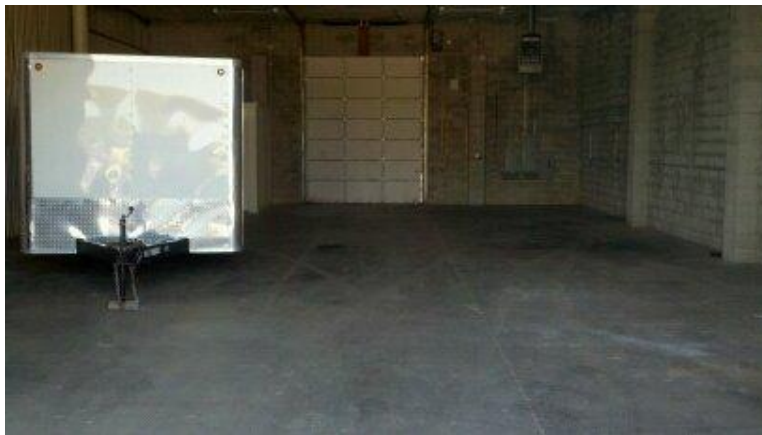

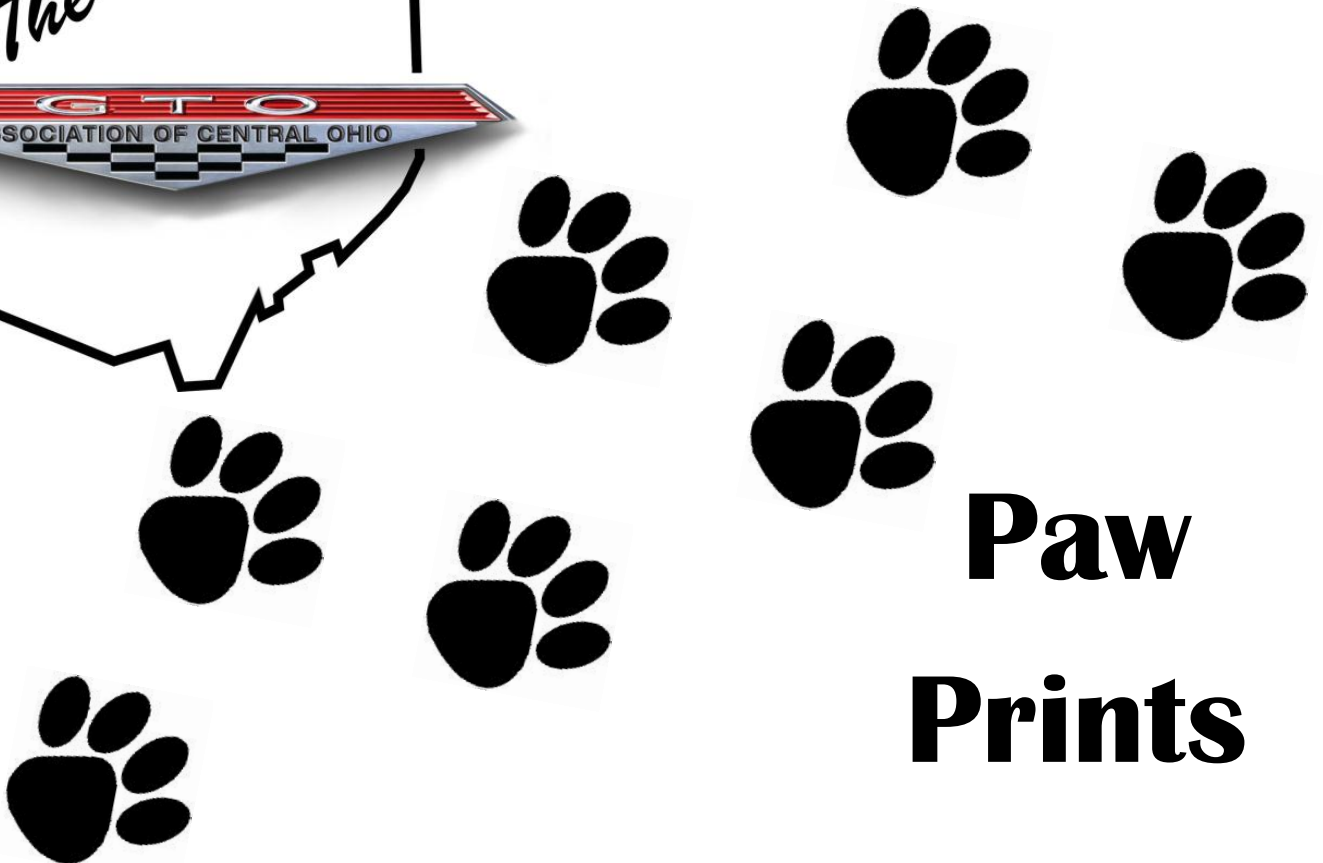
