In this issue, we've got coverage in pictures of the 2012 Swap Meet and some cool pictures of a sweet 507 horsepower 64 GTO.

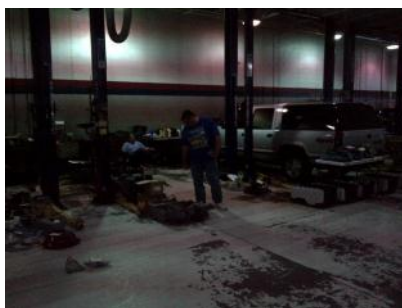

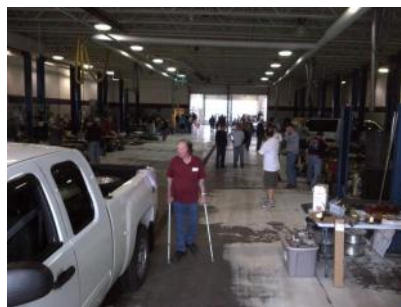
2012 Swap Meet

1964 GTO “Sabertooth”

This 1964 Pontiac GTO, "Sabertooth", was on display at the Hotrod and Restoration Trade Show in Indianapolis. It was built by Penfound Design in Elyria, Ohio. It has the original 389 engine bored and stroked to 449 cubic inches. They are running Ram Air IV style aluminum heads, Barry Grant Tri-Power, and reproduction Ram-Air IV exhaust manifolds. This performance street engine makes 507 horsepower and 528 foot pounds of torque. This GTO wins my award for Muscle Car of The Year.
