Rochester 2 Barrel Carburetor by Steve Schaeffer

The Rochester 2 barrel carburetor was used by General Motors on its V-8 engines from the mid 50's thru the late 70's. It is most famous for its use on the General's three carburetor set-ups. Maximum engine performance requires perfect distribution of large quantities of gas and air mixture. Three 2 barrel carbs gave a smooth low end when running off the center carb. When you kicked in the two end dump carbs the performance and the roar was outstanding. What set off the Oldsmobile J-2 Rocket engines in 1957 and 1958 as well as the W-30 Tri-Power option on the '66 442 was the three 2 barrel carburetor set-up.



Tri-Power was a staple of Pontiac performance from 1957 thru 1966. It started in 1957 and 1958 using three of the small base 2GC Rochester carburetors. This was the same as Chevy on their 348 engine and Olds on the J-2. Chevy stuck with three of the small base carbs on the 348 from 1958 thru 1961. From 1959 thru 1965 Pontiac used the small base Rochester 2GC carb as the center carb on the tri-power and a large base carb on the front and rear of the manifold. The final year of production, 1966, found both Pontiac and Oldsmobile using all three big base 2 GC Rochester carbs. These big base carburetors are said to flow 350 cfm each. So these high performance engines were certainly not under carbureted.

The center carburetor was known as the primary and it had all the usual systems for operation. The center carb had the normal idle, choke, part throttle, and full throttle systems. The front and rear carburetors were simply dump carburetors. They did not have idle, part throttle, or choke systems. These systems were very easy to tune. You do have to be careful about fuel leaks and flooding. You have 3 fuel lines, 3 needle and seats, and 3 floats to adjust.

The early three carburetor systems used mechanical linkage to open the center carb. The two end carbs were controlled by vacuum linkage. They were either open or closed. Starting in 1965 Pontiac went to mechanical linkage on all their standard shift engines as did Olds in 1966. This was a big improvement. Today almost all of the street driven Tri-Power carb setups have been retrofit with mechanical progressive linkage if they didn't have it from the factory.

These carburetors are really a very basic design. They are not difficult to rebuild. Just be sure to use good quality parts. The float settings have to be dead on. Also pay attention to the size of the hole in the needle and seat valve. It looks like some kits come with a needle and seat that is really for a Quadrajets 4 barrel carb and it flows too much fuel. I have had good luck using a NAPA Echlin needle and seat part number 2-3509. On tri-power carbs I always use original style brass floats. Flooding can be prevented by not running too much fuel pressure. A fuel pressure regulator can save a lot of headaches. These carbs require volume but not high pressure. Use high quality fuel lines and fittings to prevent leaks.



Rochester 2GC carburetors were also used on boats. Some Merc Marine 2GCs used a spring loaded needle and seat. I haven't tried this yet but it could help prevent a float sticking, especially on an end carb that may not get dumped in all the time.

When disassembling your carb pay attention to where the springs and check balls go. The exploded view that comes with the carb kit is very helpful. Save all the old gaskets to match up with the new ones. A lot of these kits have several different gaskets in them to make the kits more universal. Carefully turn the mixture adjusting screws on the center carb into the seated position. Count the number of turns so you can reset them in the same place. Clean the disassembled parts with carburetor cleaner. You can use a stiff bristle brush to remove dirt, old gasoline residue, and carbon. Don't use any kind of abrasives or wires to clean parts and passageways. When you have finished cleaning everything I use hot water and compressed air for the final cleanup before assembly.

Big single and dual 4 barrel carburetors and fuel injection have now taken over on the street and on the race track. But nothing beats the look and the sound of 3 roaring carburetors.

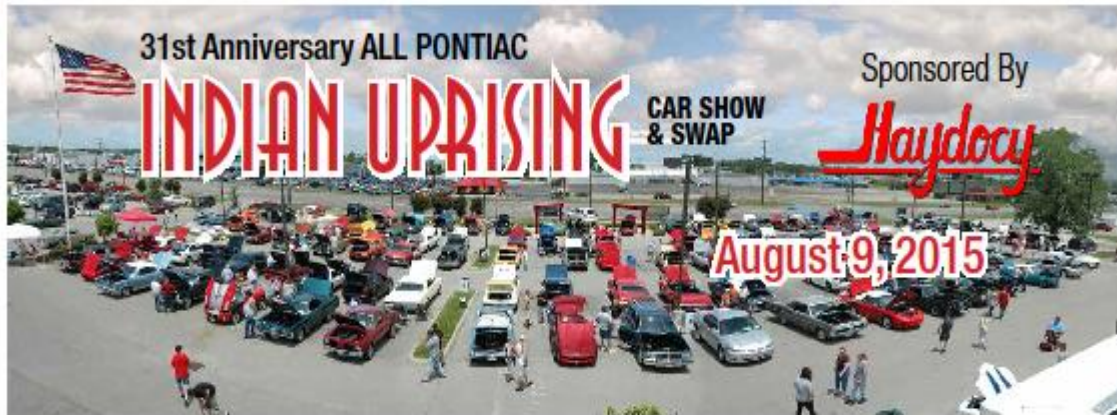

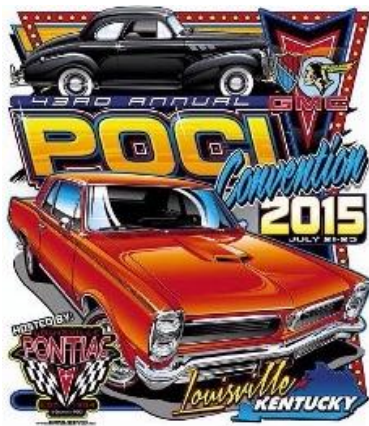
