Letter from the President, March 2015

As many of you are aware, with the unfortunate passing of Bill Hartley, we have been reevaluating the Paw Prints distribution. For many years, Bill donated the printing of the mailed version each month. Since his passing, we made an effort to contact as many members receiving the Paw Prints by postal mail as possible, to see if we could convert them to email delivery. Of the approximately 70 members in our February roster, 27 choose to receive the Paw Prints in the mail rather than by email. We were only successful in converting a few of those to email delivery.

It is our goal to provide the information contained in the Paw Prints to all GTO-ACO members, equally. Whether it is delivered by postal mail, or electronically, we will provide the same content. To continue to provide the black and white Paw Prints by postal mail, it will cost the club approximately \$26/yr for each member choosing postal delivery. This exceeds our current total club dues of \$20/yr/member.

After reviewing this information in the February club meeting, a motion was made and passed to increase club dues for members requesting postal delivery of the Paw Prints to \$30/yr. This new rate will become effective for renewals beginning in January 2016. This allows members time to consider obtaining an email address if they choose. New memberships requesting postal delivery will be \$30 starting immediately. Dues for members using email delivery of the Paw Prints will continue to be \$20.

On July 2nd, Jerry Blackstone and I attended the ribbon cutting ceremony and grand opening of Bob McDorman 's Automotive Museum. The museum is located at 45 East Waterloo Street in Canal Winchester. He transformed the old Cellar Lumber Yard building into a modern 22,000 square foot facility at a cost of 1.5 million dollars.

The building will display 50 cars. Currently there are 38 cars on display. The walls are lined with his vast automotive sign and memorabilia collection. He also has vintage gas pumps on display and a significant number of promo model cars.

In 2015 Bob will have been a Chevrolet dealer for 50 years. He still owns a 15% stake in his former dealership.

Bob 's current office is in the front of the museum. His desk is flanked by two 1978 Corvette Pace Cars. One is serial number 3, and the other is the last '78 Pace Car built.

Bob has been an avid car collector for a number of years. The collection is a lot more than just Corvettes. When you get time it is worth stopping by. It just costs \$10.00 admittance. Seniors and veterans are \$7.00.


