# In Memory of Dan Gregory, Sr.

## “Krazy” Dan the GTO Man

If you ever had a chance, and you should have been so lucky, to have heard my father tell a story then you know firsthand what a great story teller he was. So it is fitting that when his spirit left this earth that it was truly indeed a great story.

I was 5 when I watched E.T at the local drive-in standing up in the back of dad's 67 convertible.



It was this car that he was turning into a GTO that started everything. Piece by piece he gathered what he needed to complete the transformation. Through this searching and collecting he found himself with extras and so the beginning of what we have shared for the last 33 years began.



Perhaps you met “Krazy” Dan the GTO Man at one of the GTOAA events (he made it to 24 of 36 of them), or maybe at a GTOACO show or swap meet, a POCI meet, Carlisle, Norwalk, Woodward dream cruise or made it down to the shop. No matter where he was you always knew about his passion for these cars and that he do whatever he could to try to help you, whether he knew you or not. His eyes would light up every time someone would tell them about “their” car and why it was “special”. Truth is all these cars are “special” because people like my dad made them “special”.



Dad was a dreamer, he felt that everyone should have the opportunity to enjoy these cars. So why not start the GTO National Museum? So he did! Cards, signs for the “courtesy” cars and a website [gtonationalmuseum.org](http://gtonationalmuseum.org), everything you need, except someone who knows how to run a non-profit organization. That did not stop him from telling people about his dream and wanting to share his experiences with them. Dad also started a car show for our Veterans at the local VA hospital in Chillicothe, OH. Many of those guys never have the chance to leave the hospital grounds, so why not just bring the show to them?

As I look back over the last year, it seems that everything that he did was in preparation for July 11th 2015. Some people just seem to know when they are ready and I truly believe that dad did. How else could he have made it out of the hospital (foot infection) on the day that we left to come over to the Nationals and then make it out of the hospital in Columbus, Indiana (stomach illness) the morning of his passing? He did it so he could be there, sitting in his chair, watching me, helping me anyway he could as we both did what we love to do so much.



## In Memory of Dan Gregory, Sr.

May we all be as lucky as to die doing what we love, surrounded by people we love and that we know love us and to pass quickly and quietly without pain or suffering? To allow peace into the hearts of those that loved him so much and leave behind memories that we will cherish forever. Dad used to say "I am a LEGEND in my own mind" .....No dad, you truly are a LEGEND to me a the countless lives that you touched.



The GTO world will miss Dan Gregory Sr. and I will miss my father and best friend every day. But dad did not want anyone to sit around and shed tears for him. Instead he wanted everyone to remember him for who he was with his infectious laughter, big smile and always inviting personality. So when you think of dad, please laugh out loud and remember something about him that will put a smile on your face.
