GTOACO at On the Rocks Spring Cruise-In







The club was out in force at On the Rocks 'Spring Cruise-In! In attendance were Stan Farlow,
 Brent Barham, Mike Shockley, Ron Cozzo, Bill Sigg, Jeff Frazier, Dan Kirchner, Mike Berischon
 and me (Kevin Russo). It was a beautiful day with a ton of beautiful cars. A good show to attend. We will have to try to hit the fall version of the cruise!

'69 Firebird Sprint 6 OHC by Steve Schaeffer

Everything we work on here isn 't a GTO or a 442 or a race car.

Probably 20/25 years ago my brother Michael and I restored a '69 Firebird with the Pontiac overhead cam six cylinder engine. We added the Pontiac Sprint Six package consisting of a Rochester Q-Jet 4 barrel carburetor and intake, and the factory split exhaust manifold with dual

pipes. We did not add either one of the Sprint 6 factory cams because we didn 't want to kill off any low end torque. The car was originally equipped with the Buick built Turbine 300 2 speed automatic that everyone thinks is a Chevy Powerglide.

Over the years the car was continually updated as most project cars are. When the Turbine 300 front pump started to sing, we installed a Turbo 350 3 speed automatic transmission. The Shift Works sold a conversion kit to retain the original floor shift and console with the new transmission. The only give away is the shifter plate now has an extra

forward speed on it and the kick down cable for passing gear.

We also changed it over to power disc brakes. The rear end ratio was switched from a 2;56 airplane gear to a 3:08 ratio. A Grant wood steering wheel with the Pontiac arrowhead horn emblem adds a touch of class and looks factory correct. The hood tach that we added is really a sweet touch and the factory redline is 6,500 RPM. Don 't try that with your stock Muscle Car V-8 with a stock hydraulic lifter cam.

With the red exterior, white convertible top, black interior, 14x7 Pontiac Rally II wheels, and 225-70-14 Firestone outline white letter tires this is a really sharp car.



When my brother first put the car together he had new quarter skins installed. Recently some bubbles appeared on the seams where the quarters were welded in. I was sure they were rust bubbles but they were not. Wally called it "p opcorn" and said it was where pin holes had developed in the paint and water got under it. I took the car to Auto Body Supply in Lancaster.

They had a computerized spectrograph that could determine the formula for paint that was an exact match and even compensates for the natural fading that is going to occur over the years.

Wally took the bad areas down to bare metal, filled in with all metal as necessary, then a very thin coat of body filler. Of course the next step was blocking and sanding. He also installed a new deck lid because the old one had some rust repair and minor damage. He then painted the car from the rear of one door to the other and got a perfect color match.

While the car was here we decided to fix all the oil seepage that any vintage car will have. We pulled the transmission and resealed it and painted it grey. No one will ever see it but it looks great. We also replaced the transmission cross member with a rust free freshly painted unit. This one isn 't carefully lettered, "It should have been a V-8.", don 't know who did that.

Things got interesting when we decided to reseal the engine as well. Even though the '69 Chevy 6 cylinder engine is 250 cubic inches same as the Pontiac no parts interchange. None of the parts stores carry gaskets for the Pontiac OHC 6. First they tried to sell us gaskets for a Chevy 250 6 cylinder. Nothing is the same. We contacted Jerry Woodland of Woodland Sports, The Overhead Cam Source, 435-258-5660, woodlandsports@gmail.com. He stocks all the parts you can think of for this engine. He also stocks rebuilt short blocks and cylinder heads. He also has all 3 of the camshafts; 1 barrel, 4 barrel "E" cam, and the high performance 230 horsepower "H" 4 barrel cam. With an overhead cam, belt driven, not chain, a 6,500 RPM red line and a potential 230 horsepower out of 250 cubic inches this is an engine that was ahead of it 's time. It also makes for a great collector car.
