CHAPTER BY LAWS

Section I - Chapter address

The mailing address of the chapter shall be:

Chapter name GTO Association of Central Ohio

Street 3062 Scioto Trace

Section II - Duties of the Officers

- a. President: The President shall preside at all meetings, and shall be the chief executive of the club. He shall have general supervision over the development of its entire program. He shall make all committee appointments subject to approval by the general membership of the chapter.
- b. Vice-President: Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in his/her absence, and other duties as may be prescribed by the members.
- c. Secretary: The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings and maintain a file of reports, a file of correspondence, and maintain an up-to-date record of any business of the chapter.
- d. Treasurer: The Treasurer shall be responsible for the collection of chapter fees, and the maintaining of financial records regarding the chapter's receipts and expenditures.

Section III - Meetings

- a. The regular meetings of this chapter shall be held on the second wednesday of each month.
- b. Special meetings of the chapter shall be held on call of the President, or upon a written call to the chapter membership.

Section IV - Elections

- a. It is understood that all officers and directors shall serve without remuneration.
- b. After one year, the officers, and directors, if any, will be elected by the majority vote.

Section V - Committees

- a. Committees shall be appointed by the President as outlined in Section II (a).

Section VI - Amendments

- a. The by-laws may be amended by a majority vote, at any regularly scheduled chapter meeting.

GTO ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA

CHAPTER CONSTITUTION

Article I - Name

- a. The name of this organization shall be:

GTO Association of Central Ohio

Article II - Purpose

This organization is formed pursuant to the authority granted the board of directors of the GTO Association of America, by the Articles of Incorporation of said association, Article III, section (B).

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote the preservation, enjoyment and restoration of Pontiac GTO automobiles, to educate both public and legislative bodies at all levels of these cars' extraordinary contributions to the world's automotive, social and industrial history.

Article III - Membership

Membership in this organization is open to any active member of The GTO Association of America who lives within this organization's geographical area.

Article IV - Officers

The officers of this organization shall be President, Vice-President, and Secretary and Treasurer.

The duties of the officers shall be prescribed in the by laws.

Officers shall be elected in the manner prescribed by the by laws.

Article V - Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of members present at a regularly called meeting.

The call of the meeting must include the proposed amendments.

Article VI

The initial board of directors shall constitute three (3) Directors, and their respective names and addresses are as follows:

Article VII

The offices of the said board of directors shall be determined and the method by which they are elected shall be governed by the bylaws of this Chapter. The terms of office of the board of directors, the quorum necessary for the transaction of the business at any regular or special meeting of said board of directors, the necessary notice of all meetings of the Chapter, and the number of members of the Chapter and the method by which they are selected shall be governed by the bylaws of the Chapter. The bylaws of the Chapter may be adopted by the directors at any regular meeting or special meeting called for this purpose.

Article VIII

Upon the dissolution of the Chapter, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Chapter, all of the assets of the Chapter shall revert to the GTO Association of America.

Torq Storm Superchargers by Steve Schaeffer

I have seen ads for the Torq Storm Billet Superchargers in several of the Hot Rod magazines that I subscribe. It comes as a complete bolt on kit. Since it uses a blow thru carburetor, hood clearance is not a problem. At Good Guys I was able to examine the supercharger and the complete installation kit and talk to the factory rep. [Rick Lewis, 616-706-5580]

For a 326-455 Pontiac V-8 the kit is part number ARP-K-GM-P326-455. With a natural billet finish the price of the kit is \$2,800.00. Add \$250.00 for black or \$535.00 for polished finishes. This is a precision machined from solid billet aluminum centrifugal supercharger. The kit includes the supercharger, hoses, tubes, blow off valve, air filter, carb hat, and all necessary brackets, pulleys and hardware for a complete installation. Projected horsepower increase on a street engine is 40%! On a mild 400 horsepower engine we are talking about adding 160 horsepower.

For the supercharger to work properly, you will also need a Holley style mechanical secondary blow thru carb of 750 CFM. You will also need a fuel pressure regulator with a 1 to 1 rise ratio. The fuel pressure has to increase from a normal 6 psi to 12 psi under boost. An electric fuel pump is needed that can supply 15 psi. With cast pistons limit boost to 6 pounds. Your camshaft should have a lobe center of 112 to 116 degrees.

Looking in the Jegs catalog a Demon 750 cfm blow thru carb, part number 333-5402020BT costs \$699.95. I found the correct Aeromotive fuel pressure regulator part number 027-13204.... A1000 at a price of \$180.99. The Aeromotive electric fuel pump part number 027-11203 capable of 18 to 20 psi costs \$204.99.

I also spoke with a tech at C&S Specialities, 636-723-4996 and he told me that with a blow thru carburetor application you need to use a 360 degree single plane intake manifold. I didn't confirm this with the Torq Storm rep but the Summit catalog lists the Edelbrock Torker II intake for a Pontiac 389-455, 1965-1979 for \$269.97.

Look at the picture. With 560 plus horsepower, it looks pretty interesting.

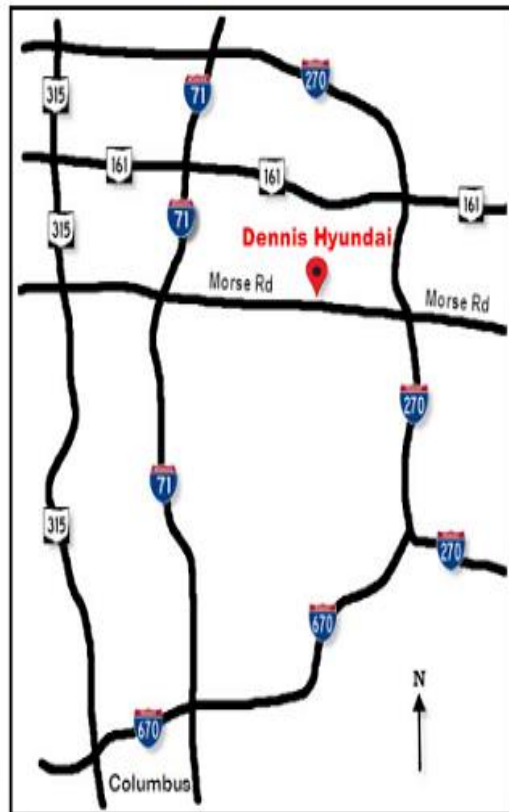
