Penske Racing Museum by Steve Schaeffer

With Team Penske in the news, they just signed driver Joey Logano, crew chief Todd Gordon, and sponsor Shell-Pennzoil to new contracts. We thought we would visit the Penske Racing Museum while in Scottsdale, Arizona.

"The museum showcases an amazing collection of cars, trophies, and racing memorabilia chronicling the career of one of the most successful dynasties in all sports. Team Penske has over 50 years of racing experience and over 400 major race wins highlighted by a record setting number of Indianapolis 500 mile race victories."

There is an amazing display of significant race cars. The museum also has a café for both breakfast and lunch and a boutique with lots of Team Penske merchandise for sale.

The complex also has separate dealerships for Porsche, BMW, Audi, Jaguar/Land Rover, Ferrari/ Maserati. There are also dealerships for Bentley/Lamborghini/Bugatti, Rolls Royce/Aston Martin, MINI, Acura, and Volkswagon. In addition there is an Off Road Course.

I especially liked all the engines on display. This was something that was missing from the NASCAR Museum in Charlotte.

Of course 2 of my favorite cars were the '63 Pontiac Catalina. It was a 421 Pontiac Super Duty car with 405 horsepower, and a replica of the one that Roger Penske drove to victory at the NASCAR Riverside 250 in 1963.

My other favorite was the actual 1972 Hurst Olds Cutlass that was the 1972 Indianapolis 500 pace car. It was equipped with a 300 horsepower Olds 455 engine. They made 629 Hurst Oldsmobiles in 1972. There were 130 convertibles and 499 hardtops.
