We have about 6 weeks left in the car season and the calendar is about as busy as it gets. Hopefully, everyone is out and about and taking advantage of the good weather. Our 34th annual all Pontiac show on September 2 will be in the books by the time you read this. The club picnic on September 22 will be the next event followed by the Zoo show on October 7, then the cruise to Ravens Glenn Winery on October 20th. We also have the Greater Ohio GTO Club and Ohio Valley GTO Association car shows on September 16th.

Pam and I have been taking in the Der Dutchman weekly cruise in on Thursday evenings. This event runs every week all summer long. It is simply a "show up and look at cars for a couple of hours" event. In the last 2 years, attendance has taken off and regularly includes over 100 cars. This week there were 166 cars. 
