



or those that missed going to the 30th Annual Pontiac Tri-Power Nationals at Norwalk, I wish you could have been there. It was the biggest event in their 30-year history! On Friday, July 30th it was announced that all swap meet spots were sold out, and on Saturday around noon, the day of the car show, the loudspeaker crackled once again with the familiar voice of the announcer asking that all golfcarts be moved out of parking spaces to make way for show cars that were already through the gate. The grounds were full to capacity, and they were now having to turn cars away at the gate. The numbers were unreal for a three-day event with well over 12,000 spectators, 251 swap meet vendors

utilizing 436 spaces, 44 sale cars in the car corral, and an amazing 644 show cars as well as 428 additional cars tearing up the drag strip! These numbers didn't even include our Canadian Pontiac friends that were unable to attend due to the border closing.

The GTOACO had a great club presence at the event with no less than 10 show cars and more than 20 members in attendance bringing home not one, but four 1st Place, one 2nd Place, two 3rd Place, and one Best in Class trophies. Well done my friends!
