For me, and I'm sure like most others the anticipation of next trip to Norwalk for the Pontiac Nationals starts right after the close of the one I just left. Looking forward to meeting old friends and making new ones and seeing cars and people that show up every year as well as what's new is just some of the highlights of going to Norwalk, as most of us call it. This year marks the 3th annual Ames Performance Tri Power Pontiac Nationals and like last year is it was another huge success. Combining near perfect weather and people wanting to get out created the recipe for the second largest Nationals to date. From Ames press release here are some stats for it. Last year they added 25 additional swap meet spots and sold out Friday morning. This year they were all sold out in early June. This has never happened since the show started. There were 209 venders from 32 states, 50 vehicles in the car corral, up 6 from last year. The car show was 7 short of last year's record with 1,065. For the racers, there were 433 entries and next year they plan to expand the pits to get more participants in. As for spectators there were 10,374 people through the gates.
